Blast Off into Space Science during Little Scientist Week

TOLEDO, Ohio – – Budding scientists will explore the wonders of space during a special week dedicated to the littlest learners. Preschool children will enjoy hands-on activities that engage curiosity, inspire creativity and encourage exploration during Little Scientist Week at Imagination Station, March 12 – 17.

Little Scientist Week is designed to support children’s natural curiosity about the world around them and help build early science skills.

Children ages 3 - 5 will learn more about the invisible force that keeps their feet firmly planted on the ground as they experiment with a gravity well. Mini meteorologists will discover how clouds are made in the sky and watch with amazement as they are formed inside a bottle.

With their eyes on the stars, astronomers-in-training will explore how craters are made on the moon, and then create their own. Mini aerospace engineers will construct a paper rocket and send it soaring into the sky.
