Tinkering Space: Monstrous Shadows

Daily in October

Little Scientist Workshops Thursdays, 11:30am -12:15pm

Little Scientist Workshops are a series of programs that encourage families with children ages 3 - 5 to investigate the world around them through hands-on activities. Topics change weekly. *Registration is required and science center admission must be purchased separately for non-members. Think Tank Workshops: Super Spooky Slime Lab Saturdays, 2pm

Igneous, metamorphic and sedimentary - rocks make up the world we live on!
