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## **Imagination Station's Summer Camps deliver Pure Science. Pure Fun.**

TOLEDO, Ohio – When summer heats up, Imagination Station is the place to be for cool science! Kids ages 6 – 13 will experience a week jam-packed with experiments, challenges and projects designed for exploration and discovery. Make this a summer of science and learn about our world, meet new friends and have a blast!

micro MOLECULES Summer Camps are for kids ages 6 - 8:

- **New! Pirate-ology:** June 10 – 14; June 17 – 21; June 24 – 28  
ARRRE you ready for an adventure? Come aboard mates and explore the science that allowed pirates to sail the seven seas. These swashbuckling lads and lassies will bravely seek the treasure of the old salty sea dog, Captain Gizmo. Along the way, they will experiment with code-breaking, ship design, weather and ways to navigate the world.
- **Super Splatter Science:** July 8 – 12; July 15 - 19  
Super Splatter Science campers will make a mess and learn about their world as they spew lava from a volcano, run through pools of oobleck, tie-dye t-shirts and shoot elephant's toothpaste to the ceiling. It's a week of ooey gooey fun and campers should be ready to get wet, sticky, dirty and messy!
- **Young MacGyver:** July 22 – 26; July 29 – August 2; August 5 - 9  
When the pressure is on, MacGyver will save the day with quick thinking and a pocketful of common items. Campers will use household objects to find a simple solution to challenging problems. They will create grappling hooks, construct flashlights and even learn to pick a lock. By the end of the week, they will have tinkered their way to earning an official Young MacGyver badge!

Older kids, ages 9 -13 can choose from these MACRO molecules Summer Camps:

- **Inside the Lab:** June 10 – 14; June 17 – 21; June 24 - 28  
Why should Imagination Station's Extreme Scientists have all the fun? Campers will get a behind-the-scenes look at what it takes to become one of our team members. Prepare and perform lab experiments, ignite bubbles and set off explosions! Each week ends with an Extreme Science demonstration led by campers.
- **Cardboard Creators:** July 8 -12; July 15 -19  
Creativity and collaboration are the name of the game at this camp designed to put engineering, planning, construction and communication skills to the test. Using cardboard and household tools, campers will work together to design and build the biggest, tallest and most extreme structures possible. The bigger the better, and teams are only limited by their imagination!

The science center also offers camp opportunities at two area universities. Campers will design and engineer challenges with **Catapults, Coasters and Cars** – and make a rocket blast off, create a protective device for an egg and more. Catapults, Coasters and Cars will be offered at Bowling Green State University from June 3 – 7 and the University of Findlay from June 10 – 14.

Each week-long, fun-filled, science-stuffed camp is \$175 for Imagination Station members and \$200 for non-members. Camps fill quickly, so early registration is recommended.
