Responsibilities:

- 2-D advertising layouts, brochures, postcards and posters: brand standards are incorporated and direct supervision provided
- Production: includes in-house digital printing, trimming and minimal installation
- The design and production of exhibit and way-finding signage is included in the position; material knowledge (substrates, vinyl, laminate, etc.) will be learned

Requirements:

- 15 - 20 hours weekly
- Minimum of a 3 month commitment
- Experience working on a team
- Knowledge of CS4 or higher with an emphasis on Illustrator, Photoshop and In Design
- Expertise in Word/Excel and Hype is a plus
- Experience with verbal communication, math and presentation skills
- Helpful experience: fine art, t-shirt design, mural painting, photography, animation, web design
- Be able to pass a background check and drug test
